Project Description

Construction of a new, six-mile Bus Rapid Transit line (“The Vine”) between downtown Vancouver and Vancouver Mall. Included were 33 transit stations, an expanded and modernized maintenance facility, and a relocated transit center at the mall. Ten BRT buses were also acquired. Rider information signs, level boarding, enhanced security measures including surveillance cameras and on-platform ticket vending machines were also installed.
