## Project Description

The Project improves pedestrian safety across one of the City’s busiest streets, by warning motorist when pedestrians and bicyclists are crossing Aspen Avenue. Project also links the City trail across Aspen Avenue.

The Project included crosswalk striping, a concrete access ramp, and advanced warning signals.
