Project Goals:

- Provide access to Hazel Dell Elementary School and C-TRAN bus system
- Remove pedestrians from the vehicle lane
- Remove bicyclists from the vehicle lane
- Reduce pedestrian / motorist conflicts
- Reduce bicyclist / motorist conflicts
- Reduce pedestrian / bicyclist conflicts
- Preserve the roadway surface

Project Outcomes:

- Enhanced access to Hazel Dell Elementary School and C-Tran bus system
- Separated pedestrian and bicyclist facilities constructed
- Conflicts between pedestrians / bicyclists and vehicles reduced
- The roadway surface has been preserved

Project Description

Construct sidewalk along the east side of NE Hazel Dell Avenue, approximately 700' N of Alki Road to NE 63rd Street, and the south side of NW/NE 68th Street (NW 4th Avenue to NE Hazel Dell Avenue.).

Full-width asphalt overlay on NW/NE 68th Street using county road preservation funds.

Project Outcome Details

- Sidewalk construction has been completed.
- Pedestrian and bicyclists have been removed from the vehicle travel lane.
- Conflicts between vehicles, bicyclist and pedestrians have been reduced.
- The sidewalk connection and bicycle lane have increased multi-modal travel options for the community.
- Access to Hazel Dell Elementary School and the C-TRAN bus system have been enhanced.
- The roadway surface on NE 68th Street has been preserved.
