

C-TRAN: Fisher’s Landing Transit Center Parking Expansion and Other Amenities

Project Description

The Fisher’s Landing Transit Center, located at 3510 SE 164th Avenue, is C-TRAN’s busiest park-and-ride. With over 90 percent utilization, additional parking was needed to meet public demand. This project added 198 more parking spaces to the south parking lot, growing capacity from 560 parking spaces to 758. The project also provided an upgraded stormwater system to meet future growth, upgraded lighting, upgraded surveillance, electrical charging stations, provided additional passenger shelters, remodeled the lobby and restrooms and a water bottle drinking fountain. C-TRAN used \$203,000 of the \$800,000 CMAQ grant for design with the remaining \$597,000 being used for the Transit Oriented Development (TOD) study that is currently underway. The study completion is expected in late 2018.
